Congratulations to RDA Project Manager **Jason Apergis** on his contributions to the book [Professional K2 \[blackpearl\]](#), which releases in January!



Jason's portion of the book covers SmartObjects, InfoPath and solution deployments. SmartObjects is the newest framework that was added to the K2 blackpearl platform. It allows for visual design and integration with line of business data. In addition to SmartObjects, Jason wrote the chapter for building K2 processes that use InfoPath and the chapter on deploying K2 solutions, including all of the considerations that need to be accounted for.

Jason was invited to participate in this project based on his expertise with the K2 platform. He led a K2 project after the first production release and quickly became familiar with the product. In addition, he has gained significant experience with K2.net 2003. Jason authors a [blog](#) focused on K2 and has supported the K2 community in various other ways for several years.
